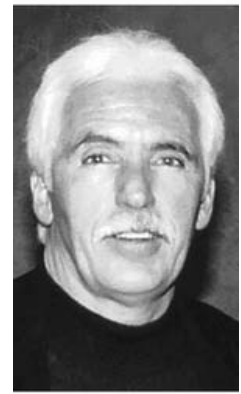




## Timothy J. Doyle Memorial Fund



Dear MRPA Members and Friends,

On October 24, 2009 Timothy J. Doyle at age 64 lost a nine year battle with ALS, Lou Gehrig's disease. Tim was a son, father, uncle, brother, husband, mentor and friend.

A Memorial Fund has been established by his friends. The fund will honor Tim's memory and his significant contributions and legacy in the field of Parks and Recreation. Contributions will be held in Tim's name within the Michigan Recreation and Park Association (MRPA) Foundation Access to Recreation Endowment Fund. Tim's Fund will work to continue his passion and advocacy for Parks & Recreation, Health and Wellness, the Outdoors and his love of children.

Tim received his Recreation undergraduate degree from the University of Wisconsin-Lacrosse and later, his Masters from Michigan State University. He then served the Park and Recreation field for more than 32 years. He was Director of Parks and Recreation for Independence Township and concurrently served as a Board Member and then Commissioner for the Metro Detroit Amateur Softball Association (MDASA) subsequently he was inducted into the MDASA Hall of Fame. He served as President of MRPA and received the MRPA's highest honor, the Fellowship Award. Tim moved to commercial recreation when he joined Engan-Tooley & Associates in 1990 as a Sales Representative and became Vice-President and a Partner in the Company which then became Engan-Tooley-Doyle & Associates, Inc.
